## **Egg Throwing**



This 'game' is best explained by watching the first part of the World Egg Throwing Championships video on YouTube.

There are no badges to earn from this crazy idea but you'll need two people to play and all you have to do is throw a raw egg between the two of you – increasing the distance between you as you go.

Perhaps we should have called this 'egg catching' because that's where much of the skill seems to be!

During Camp@Home4 – The Unhatched Egg we were seeing teams exceeding distances of 10 metres – can you and your family do better?

**Safety Tips:** Be careful catching the eggs. If it does break, be prepared to deal with possible egg or egg shell in the eyes.
