## Egg Throwing



This 'game' is best explained by watching the first part of the [World Egg Throwing Championships video on YouTube](#).

There are no badges to earn from this crazy idea but you'll need two people to play and all you have to do is throw a raw egg between the two of you – increasing the distance between you as you go.

Perhaps we should have called this 'egg catching' because that's where much of the skill seems to be!

During [Camp@Home4 – The Unhatched Egg](#) we were seeing teams exceeding distances of 10 metres – can you and your family do better?

**Safety Tips:** Be careful catching the eggs. If it does break, be prepared to deal with possible egg or egg shell in the eyes.
