## Make a Model Campsite

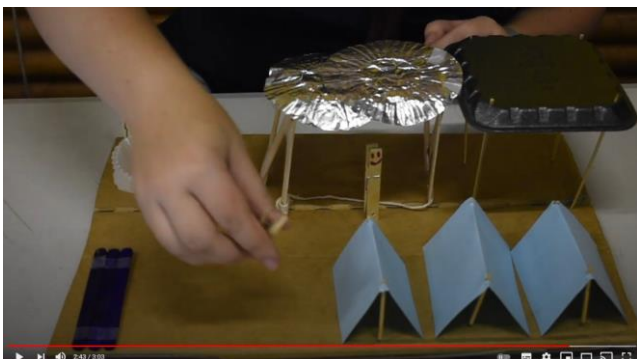
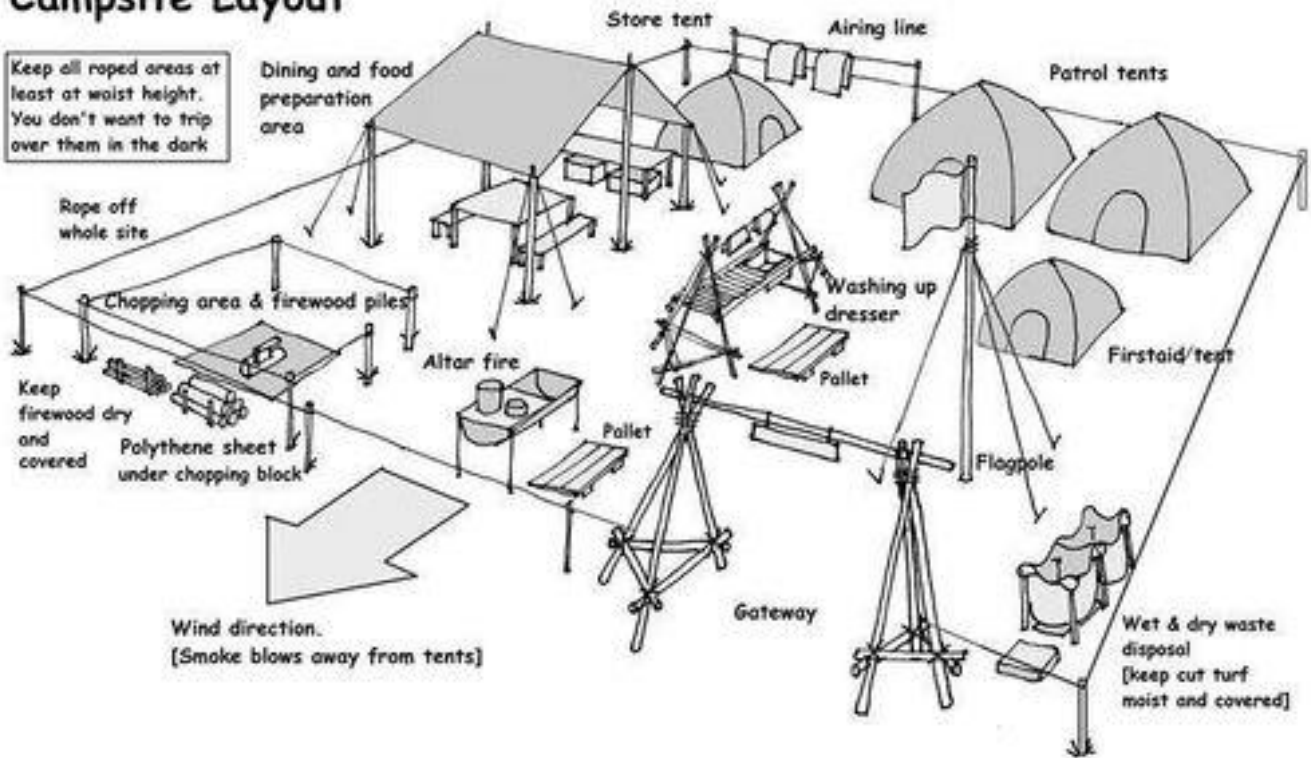
Why not try making a model of a Scout campsite?
